# **Spring Term Highlights**

Glossopdale students have been awarded over sixty thousand THRIVE points so far in the Spring Term (Jan to March 24), which is over eighteen thousand more points than the same term last year!

#### **Music for Youth Festival**

On Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March the Glossopdale School and Sixth Form Wind Band and Choir made the journey to the Albemarle Music Centre in Hull for the Music for Youth Hull Regional Festival – part of the largest youth music festival in the UK. Both groups performed their 10 minute programme in front of students from other schools taking part in the festival and two 'Music Mentors' from the Music for Youth organisation.

The choir's programme was 'Siyahamba' and 'Hushabeye Mountain' by Robert and Richard Sherman and the band performed Danny Elfman's 'Theme from Batman' and Philip Sparke's 'Klezmer Karnival. The band and choir performed excellently and received very positive and encouraging feedback from the mentors.
