Uniform Standards

GCSE and 'A' Level Exams

Students in Year 11 & Year 13 have been studying very hard for their GCSE and A-Level examinations that they will sit next term. KS3 Exams

Y8 and 9 students will be taking a series of examinations, including their core subjects: Maths, Science and English. Y9 exams will be held during the week beginning 22/04/24 and Y8 exams from 29/04/24. Some of these assessments will be taken in the Sports Hall. These are excellent preparation for sitting external exams in the future and help teachers to identify each student's strengths and next steps. We know how hard our students have been working towards them. Parents will receive a letter home with an exam timetable as well as information about resources to support revision. Please help your child plan and complete their revision so that they are fully prepared when they come to sit their exams.

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Attendance

Excellent attendance is a crucial aspect of academic success, and we aspire for all students to have at least 97% attendance. During an academic year, students that have less than 97% attendance can miss an extensive amount of learning in comparison to their peers. Furthermore, an annual attendance figure of less than 97% directly leads to lower-than-expected academic progress:

Students that consistently show excellent attendance to school are recognised and rewarded via our achievement assemblies and are also the first students invited/selected to attend rewards events in school. We do not underestimate the role of parents and carers in ensuring high levels of attendance for their children, and we really appreciate your support in ensuring that your child attends school every day, even on days when they are not feeling their best.

This week we treated our students to a fantastic surprise reward, with the return of the extremely popular silent disco events. Students with the best attendance and best conduct for Sprint Term 2 were invited to put on their dancing shoes and show us their best moves throughout the day! During the Spring Term (January to March), we have seen almost sixty thousand THRIVE points issued for excellent conduct, with over two thousand rewards badges given to our students for reaching their THRIVE points thresholds.
