Uniform

We have been really impressed with the standard of uniform and appearance for the majority of our new and returning pupils, here is just a reminder of the uniform policy for information:

<u>Glossopdale School Uniform Policy</u> This policy has been created to ensure that all students can be confident through their smart appearance and that they represent the school appropriately at all times. Our school uniform policy aims to achieve the following:

- Instil a sense of pride and community in our students
- Engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Enables uniform to be both smart and affordable for all parents/carers
- Allows additional activities such as sports to be facilitated and safe
- Can assist identification of strangers on school premises
- Is designed with health and safety in mind
- Creates a sense of professionalism and prepares students for adult life and the world of work
- Reduces the likelihood or bullying or peer pressure as all students are dressed the same
- Promotes equality amongst all students through their appearance (we want students to be defined by the content of their character and not by what they wear)
- By having a standard uniform the focus is less on how students look, enabling them to focus on their learning

Please be mindful of the following:

- acrylic nails, nail polish, false eyelashes and excessive make-up are not permitted
- only one pair of plain studs is permitted in each ear and no other piercings are allowed
- only plain black socks are permitted (no sports logos)

Attendance Recording in Schools

You may be interested to know that maintaining accurate registers is a statutory and legal requirement in schools. There are a range of codes that are used when marking the registers.

Here are some examples and when they may be used-

Present – the mark that we like best! At Glossopdale we aspire to an attendance rate of 97% or above. Anything below 90% is classed as persistent absence.

Late (before close of registers) – students can be assigned a late mark before the close of registers if they arrive no later than 9.30am

Late (after the registers close at 9.30) – in this case students will be assigned a U code which will affect their mark for the morning. As a student, sometimes you can't help being late but please try to minimise this, and get here as early as you can. A U code is classed as an absence for the morning session.

Authorised absences – may include illness where school has been notified; other authorised circumstances may include emergency family circumstances, bereavement / funerals or medical appointments, for example.

Educational trips / sporting activities / work experience/ educated off-site – these are marked on the registers using the relevant code and will be counted as being present by the attendance team if approved.

Unauthorised absences – where no reason or no satisfactory reason has been provided for the absence, such as un-authorised holidays in term-time.

Exceptional circumstances – such as being closed due to snow / bad weather, industrial action days. These absences will not affect attendance figures.

We ask parents / carers to carefully consider the impact of holidays in term-time. Holidays in term-time will be classed as an unauthorised absence and a fixed penalty fine will be issued by the local authority.

Where a student's attendance falls below expected standards, school will contact parents / carers. Attendance meetings may be held to look at ways of supporting students to improve their attendance in school.

We hope this information is useful and ask parents / carers for support in ensuring that our students have good levels of attendance in school. Please contact our attendance team if you need any more information.

DofE Bronze Award

Year 9 students are invited to start their Bronze DofE Award. This is an excellent opportunity to develop a wide range of skills and interests. The full Bronze Award costs £150 (paid in 3 instalments; October, February and May). This includes registration with DofE, access to an eDofE account, DofE discount card and regular support with a member of staff to complete the skill, volunteer and physical section. Training and supervision on a one night one day training expedition and supervision and assessment on a two day and one night qualifying expedition in the Peak District.
