* Once it is done, listen to the recording of the text and practise each sentence at the time following your text with a ruler.

* Practise reading the text aloud by yourself at home.

(In the lesson: cover your ears so you are not distracted by others reading).

* Spend time memorising the spelling and pronunciation for your mini test every week.

Look at the dodgy English translation as it will help you to remember the different word order between French and English and will also help you to remember words that we are using a lot in French but not in English (Eg.: the)

* Regarding the spelling, do some self-quizzing for homework: this means doing LOOK, COVER, SAY, WRITE CHECK (on rough paper / back of exercise book) for every sentence. Don't move to the next sentence before you know the first one very well without any spelling mistake.

"Check" means that with a green pen you tick each letter of every word you wrote and correct any mistakes with your green pen above. If you made a mistake with the spelling of the word you need to practise a bit more!
